ADDITIONAL CHARGES:

Hot lunch-Pricing information is available upon request. Morning care opens at 7:30 a.m. Cost is \$3.00 per day. Aftercare hours are 3:20 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. 3:20 - 3:30 p.m. cost is \$3.00. If a student is picked up after 3:30 p.m., aftercare is charged at the rate of \$5.00 per half hour, from 3:30 until 5:30 p.m. *Any time after 5:30 is \$1.00 per minute.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The matriculation fee of \$100 will be required to complete the registration process. To avoid a price increase, book fees are due by June 1, 2024. All payments must be paid by August 1, 2024, to guarantee enrollment. Fees must be paid in the form of check or cash to the school office.

Graduation fees are due May 1, 2025.

Refunds cannot be made on registration, book and matriculation fees, uniforms, monthly tuition for the current month, after/morning care, or lunchroom charges. If the student withdrawals early, unused tests and quizzes will not be returned. Students may keep their textbooks or donate them to the school.

Aftercare, morning care, and lunchroom charges will be billed on the monthly statement and are payable on receipt.

The annual tuition is divided into ten monthly installments payable on the first of the month, beginning August 1, 2024, and continuing through May 1, 2025. This is the minimum amount that may be paid monthly unless a special payment plan contract has been completed, signed, and on file in the office.

Payments may be made any time before the due date. There is a grace period of 10 days before payment is considered late.

A \$20 late fee on any past-due account will be assessed on the 11th of the month, regardless of which day the tenth falls.

Accounts on which a check is rejected by the bank for reasons of, but not limited to, non-sufficient funds, etc., will be assessed a fee of \$25.00. If such a transaction causes the account to become delinquent, the late fee will be assessed monthly until the account is current. After the second bank rejection, all payments must be in the form of a bank check, money order, or cash.

If the account is delinquent for more than 30 days, the student may be financially withdrawn from the school until payment or arrangements have been made.

Transcripts, report cards, or records will be released once all financial obligations are met.

The school has the right to charge the account for any damages done to the school by the student to cover the expense of repairing or replacing damaged property.
